
## Can you explain some of the strong points that you have seen at Horizon International School from your recent visits and conversations?

EVERYONE COUNTS, EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES, EVERYONE SUCCEEDS IS OUR MOTTO, YET WE HAVE A DEEPER VISION IN OUR SCHOOL. 

FROM A YOUNG AGE I ALWAYS HAD A PASSION FOR ICT AND THE FIELDS SURROUNDING IT WITH MY DAD HAVING A LARGE IMPACT ON IT TEACHING ME FROM A YOUNG AGE HOW DIFFERENT DIGITAL DEVICES WORK AND HOW THEY MASSIVELY BENEFIT THE WORLD.

DURING YEAR 9 I HAD SOME OF MY **FIRST** MY **OPPORTUNITIES** TO TRULY DEVELOP UNDERSTANDING THROUGHOUT THINGS LIKE INNOVATION DAY WHERE I DESIGNED AND MADE A MOTION SENSOR LIGHTBULB. I ALSO HAD THE GREAT TO JOIN THE OPPORTUNITY STEAMATHLON COMPETITION WHERE WE MADE OUR ROBOTS AND USED THEM TO PLAY DIFFERENT GOLF COURSES WHICH I WAS ABLE TO TAKE PART IN THROUGH YEAR 9 AND YEAR 10 AND WAS PART OF THE TEAM WHO WON THE WHOLE COMPETITION.

SINCE THEN, I'VE BEEN INVOLVED MASSIVELY IN THE DIGITAL AND INNOVATION ASPECT OF THE SCHOOL BEING A DIGITAL LEADER AND GETTING THE DIGITAL AND INNOVATION SCHOLARSHIP THIS YEAR. I HAVE BEEN HOSTING DIFFERENT PARENT WORKSHOPS AND TAKING THE LEAD ON BRINGING A-LEVEL ICT TO THE SCHOOL MAKING MY YEAR GROUP THE FIRST YEAR TO EVER TAKE A-LEVEL ICT IN THE SCHOOL. OVERALL, IT HAS BEEN AN EXCITING EXPERIENCE COMING TO DUBAI AND BEING ABLE TO FULLY CHASE MY PASSION AND INTERESTS AND I HOPE TO TAKE IT FURTHER INTO MY LIFE IN UNIVERSITY AND INTO MY WORKING LIFE.

I HOPE THAT AS A DIGITAL SCHOLAR ONCE I MOVE ON FROM THE SCHOOL AND HOPEFULLY COME BACK TO VISIT I CAN SEE THE MASSIVE IMPROVEMENTS HORIZON HAS TAKEN TO CONTINUE TO DIGITALIZE OUR LEARNING AND GIVE STUDENTS DIFFERENT OPPORTUNITIES TO CHASE THEIR GOALS AND AMBITIONS, AND I ENCOURAGE YOU ALL TO GET YOURSELF FAMILIAR WITH TECHNOLOGY AT THE VERY LEAST AS IT IS A CRUCIAL PART OF OUR DAILY LIFE AND NO MATTER WHO YOU ARE, YOU ARE GOING TO HAVE TO COME ACROSS IT IN YOUR WORK AND LEARN HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THE PEOPLE ONLINE.

IT IS VERY RARE TO MEET VARIETY OF PEOPLE IN ONE PLACE. MEMORIES FROM EXPO 2020 WILL ALWAYS MAKE US SMILE. I WISH EVERYONE THIS KIND OF ADVENTURE.



## WHAT DO YOU FEEL THE EXPO 2020 HAS BROUGHT TO YOUNG PEOPLE OVER THE PAST 6 MONTHS?

YOUNG PEOPLE HAD A CHANCE TO EXPERIENCE THE WHOLE WORLD IN ONE PLACE, DISCOVER COUNTRIES THAT THEY HAVE NEVER BEEN TO AND LEARN THAT THE WORLD IS FULL OF OPPORTUNITIES. WE JUST NEED TO "CONNECT OUR MINDS" AND BELIEVE IN OUR DREAMS. PAVILIONS FULL OF TECHNOLOGY FROM THE FUTURE AND COLOURFUL VISUAL EFFECTS PROVED THAT EVEN VISIONARY IDEAS MIGHT COME TRUE.

#### HOW HAS THE POLAND PAVILION AT EXPO APPROACHED INSPIRING THE FUTURE GENERATION WITH REGARDS TO INNOVATION?


THIS QUESTION COULD BE ANSWERED IN TWO WAYS. IN POLAND PAVILION WE HAVE WORKSHOP AREA WHERE WE CAN OFFER A RANGE OF INNOVATIVE TOYS AND GAMES FOR THE YOUNGEST GENERATION: SKRIWARE ROBOTS, 3D PRINTERS BUT ALSO MUSIC INSTRUMENTS THAT TEACH DIGITAL COMPETENCES IN ANALOGUE WAY. KIDS CAN COME, PLAY AND LEARN THINGS WHICH OLDER GENERATIONS DIDN'T HAVE A CHANCE TO KNOW. THIS IS SOMETHING EXTRAORDINARY THAT YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE A CHANCE TO DISCOVER ADVANCED TECHNOLOGIES, LIKE 3D-PRINTED MODULE OF OUR ARTISTIC INSTALLATION, KNOWING THAT IT WAS PRODUCED IN THE SAME WAY AS SOME DEVICES USED IN SPACE! BUT ON THE OTHER HAND, BY USING NATURAL WOOD IN A CONSTRUCTION OF OUR PAVILION, WE WANTED TO SHOW THAT INSPIRATIONS CAN ALSO COME FROM THE PAST, NATURAL MATERIALS, TRADITIONS AND THE NATURE MIGHT BE ALSO INNOVATIVE AND BRING NEW BRILIANT SOLUTIONS.

# WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE TO YOUNG PEOPLE WHO ARE LOOKING AT FUTURE CAREER PATHS AND ARE UNSURE OF WHAT SECTOR TO GET INVOLVED IN?

THE LEITMOTIV OF OUR PRESENTATION WAS "CREATIVITY INSPIRED BY NATURE". WE WANTED TO SHOW THAT A KEY TO SUCCESS IS CREATIVITY, INGENUITY AND PERSISTENCE. KEEPING THE EYES AND MIND OPEN ALLOWS US TO CHOOSE A RIGHT WAY. EXPO GAVE US ALL A LOT OF INSPIRATIONS, THOSE WE HAVE TO DEVELOP TO ACHIEVE SOMETHING BIGGER.

NEXT TERM, YEAR 1 HAVE THE PLEASURE OF CONDUCTING AN IMPACT TRIAL USING MATATALAB PRO KIT. THIS INVOLVES STUDENTS CREATING OR RECREATING STORIES WITH THEIR FAVOURITE CHARACTER AND ENABLING THE BOT TO MOVE AROUND USING COMPUTATIONAL THINKING, PROBLEM SOLVING, CODING AND DEBUGGING SKILLS.




## 'We need strong partnerships to succeed.'

- Collaboratively read through the 5 steps of your chosen WALKTHRU;
- Plan when and where you'll try this WALKTHRU and be observed;
- Talk through and verbalise how you plan to do the WALKTHRU step-by-step.




FRAME OF THE WALKTHRU

Observers should have their WALKTHRU book with them and consider how each step is actioned. This should be a short 5-10 minute observation ONLY looking at this WALKTHRU.



POINT COMMUNICATION

As timely as possible, meet with your partner and give specific feedback on each step of the observed WALKTHRU, using the book as the guide and reference point.




